# AAUW-VA VOTING BEGINS ON APRIL 26!

### AAUW of Virginia Branch Members:

Because it's been several weeks now since you received the <u>2020 Voter Guide</u> in the 2020 Winter/Spring Vision, we want to refresh your memory on the highlights of the upcoming election and voting process:

- 1. All AAUW of Virginia members as of **April 1** are eligible to vote in the 2020 election.
- We are voting on the following four officer positions for two-year terms beginning July 1, 2020: Co-Presidents, Vice President for Communications, Vice President for Program, and Co-Vice Presidents for Public Policy, as well as on a proposed AAUW-VA bylaws amendment and the proposed AAUW-VA 2020-2022 Public Policy Priorities. The <u>2020 Voter Guide</u> contains information on the candidates running, the bylaws amendment and public policy priorities, as well as on the voting process and timeline.
- 3. Even though candidates are running unopposed, it is critical that you vote because we need a quorum of seven percent of our membership voting in the election so that the newly elected state officers can take office on July 1, 2020.
- Because we are voting online and a link to the online ballot will be emailed to your email address of record in the <u>AAUW Member Services Database</u>, please go to the Member Services Database by March 22 and make sure your email address is current. The <u>2020 Voter Guide</u> contains information on updating your email address.
- 5. The online voting will open on **April 26 and close on May 16 at 11:45 p.m.** This is the second year we will be using software from ElectionBuddy, an outside vendor, for the election so carefully monitor your incoming emails. We'll let you know when the link to the online ballot has been emailed so in case you do not receive it, you can check your email "Junk" or "Spam" files.
