PUBLIC POLICY

MARY ELLEN MEHLER

Our Co-VPs for Public Policy, **Janine Greenwood and Denise Murden**, have alerted us to welcome news regarding support for public education decided upon by the Virginia General Assembly this month. This issue always remains one of high priority for AAUW of Virginia.

Our Co-VPs report that the General Assembly passed a compromise twoyear spending plan that boosts funding for education and other priorities without increasing taxes. Votes in both the Senate and House of Delegates were nearly unanimous. The new budget will include a 3 percent raise in each of the next two years for teachers, as well as big increases in funding for K-12 schools, higher

education, and mental health services.

- Melissa LaDuke, Dianne Owens, Sona Pancholy and Christine Schmitz have been elected to serve on the AAUW National Board of Directors.
- The open membership initiative did not pass. Changes to AAUW's bylaws require 2/3 majority (66.6%) to pass. AAUW members voted 65.1% to approve the measure, just shy of passing.
